- a. Currently exploring the quality of care and economic burden of NCD in Ghana. This is collaborative research between the University of Ghana Medical School led by Prof. Alfred Edwin Yawson and the Center for Integration Science (CIS) in Global Health Equity, University of Harvard led by Prof. Gene Buckman.
- b. Exploring the research gap for NCDs in Ghana

### 8. RESEARCH PROJECTS

- a. **Defining and integrating essential NCD interventions in national health systems (November 2023 to Date).** This project is a collaboration between the University of Ghana Medical School led by Prof. Alfred Edwin Yawson and the Center for Integration Science (CIS) in Global Health Equity, University of Harvard led by Prof. Gene Buckman. The study seeks to build upon efforts to define priorities for noncommunicable disease (NCD) care in Ghana, understand and develop recommendations on integrated delivery of priority services. Elom's role was preparing the proposal and subsequent protocol for approval by the GHS Ethics review Committee, leading the development of data collection tools,

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recruiting and training 36 field data collectors across 3 regions, leading weekly feedback calls with the CIS group on behalf of the PI, leading workshop preparation, development of process maps, qualitative data analysis and report writing. Elom is also responsible for the overall coordination and implementation of the project in Ghana on behalf of the PI The project is currently at the data management stage and analysis stage.

- b. **Coordinator, Adherence to Paediatric ARV Regimen and the Associated Treatment Outcomes in Ghana: Role of COVID-19 Pandemic in Ghana (NACP/GHS/NFM3/02-21) (August 2022 to February, 2023).** This project involved an assessment of the role of COVID-19 on the level of adherence to paediatric antiretroviral regimen and the associated treatment outcomes in Ghana. Data was collected in four regions of Ghana namely Upper East, Bono East, Volta and Greater Accra over a 10-day period across 12 antiretroviral therapy (ART) sites. Elom's role was in the area of developing field data collection tools (survey and interview guide), undertaking desk/literature review, selection and training 9 field data collectors, undertaking qualitative interviews with key stakeholders in the Ghanaian health system, analysis of transcripts and report writing. Further, Elom was responsible for the overall coordination of the project on behalf of the PI and ensured its successful implementation.
- c. **Coordinator & Qualitative Data Analysis Lead, Assessment of Noncommunicable Disease Medicines Gap in Ghana (January, 2023 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023).** The leads for this Project were Dr. Koku Awoonor and Prof. Alfred Edwin Yawson. My role was the design, development of tools for field work, training field workers, supervising field data collection including qualitative interviews, transcription, analysis (*of qualitative and quantitative data*), report writing and overall implementation of the project. This study sought to assess the gaps that exist in the NCD medicines situation in Ghana and offer recommendations for improvement
- d. **Coordinator & Qualitative Data Analysis Lead, Implementation Research for the Evaluation of the Ghana Heart Initiative (GHI) Project (February, 2022- 31<sup>st</sup> May, 2023).** This was a project between the Department of Community Health of the University of Ghana Medical School (UGMS) and the Heidelberg Institute of Global Health (HIGH) to evaluate the Ghana Heart Initiative (GHI) project that had been implemented since 2019. The Principal Investigator for the Ghana side was Prof. Alfred Yawson. As the Project Coordinator, I was responsible for the development of the protocol for ethical approval, development of data collection tools and field work manuals, recruitment and training of field data collectors, overseeing field data collection across 100 healthcare facilities in 3 regions i.e., Greater Accra, Western and Central respectively. My other roles included seeing to the appropriate disbursement of project funds, facilitating procurement of logistics for the project, facilitating and organizing meetings between the UGMS team and the HIGH team and providing weekly updates to the PI. Elom was the Qualitative Lead for this project and played an integral role in the quantitative components as well. This work was supported by the GIZ GmbH: Grant Number: 81279368. This grant was disbursed by the GIZ within the framework of the Ghana Heart Initiative, which in turn is funded by Bayer AG.

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- e. **Coordinator, University of Ghana School of Medicine & Dentistry (UGSMD), Community Health Department, UNICEF SPRINT Project (November, 2020 April 2021)**

Elom served as the Project Coordinator for the Community Health Department of the University of Ghana School of Medicine and Dentistry on the UNICEF SPRINT Project. He reported to the overall Project Lead and Head of the Community Health Department, UGSMD- Prof. Alfred E. Yawson. The Community Health Department of the University of Ghana played the role of undertaking assessment of the project (baseline, mid and terminal). Elom's main responsibilities included leading project design and developing data collection tools for monitoring evaluation and learning. Elom led a team of 15 data collectors (*including 2 Doctors in Community Health Residency training*) and managed the assessment of approximately 122 health facilities in the Eastern Region of Ghana in less than 20 days without compromising quality, resulting in cost saving and efficiencies. He also designed a comprehensive data collection instrument that accounted for all variables expected by UNICEF and GHS. The uniqueness of this tool was its simplicity, user-friendliness and ability to be integrated into the service delivery processes to make the process more routine. It also ensured the collection of prospective data without relying on surveys to collect such variables for quality improvement purposes. The development process was also done collaboratively with all stakeholders (*i.e., UNICEF and GHS*) giving them the opportunity to critique and make all the valuable contributions necessary to ensure the robustness of the tool and it accounting for every little detail and variable of interest. The findings of this work were published through written reports and a series of presentations which resulted in the supply of oxygen concentrators and training of health facilities in the project region in IMNCI to improve newborn infant and maternal outcomes by UNICEF.


